hat do you get if you combine elegant Scandinavian design, genuinely impressive audio quality, an extensive product range that can easily be organised into a wide-ranging multinoom system, and an easy-to-use app? You get Audio Pro – Sweden's most effortlessly musical gift to the world since Abba.

The new Addon C10 Mkll
is a fine introduction to the
Audio Pro ethos. This is a
compact speaker of vaguely
boom-box proportions that
offers prodigious value for

money. Connectivity is extensive, with a couple of analogue inputs taking care of physical business while Bluetooth, Chromecast, AirPlay 2 and the dedicated Audio Pro control app cover wireless connections. It's fitted with a pair of tweeters and one 5in main driver, and provides a fantastic blend of finesse and enthusiasm.

But while it's a fine starting point for a multiroom setup, the Addon C10 MkII is by no means the only worthwhile speaker in Audio Pro's range; in fact, they're almost all well worth your time and money. As well as numerous Addons of various sizes and prices, there's the likes of the A10 (the brand's most affordable wireless speaker) and – for those who like to be able to see as well as hear where their money's gone – the Drumfire, which resembles a (slightly) miniaturised guita amplifier stack and is home to a 200W subwoofer along with three other crivers.

What these products all have in common is the best pound-for-pound sound available from a wireless

multinoom speaker range. Tonality — neutral, detalled, dynamic and balanced — is consistent; and thanks to an app that's not the most thorough but is among the most straightforward, they can form a stable and expansive multiroom system very easily indeed.
